Once you click “LOGIN” the next page will direct you to either login with your FSAID or with the Student’s Information (Student’s Name, Social Security Number and Date of Birth.) For security of information purposes, we encourage students to login with their FSAID.

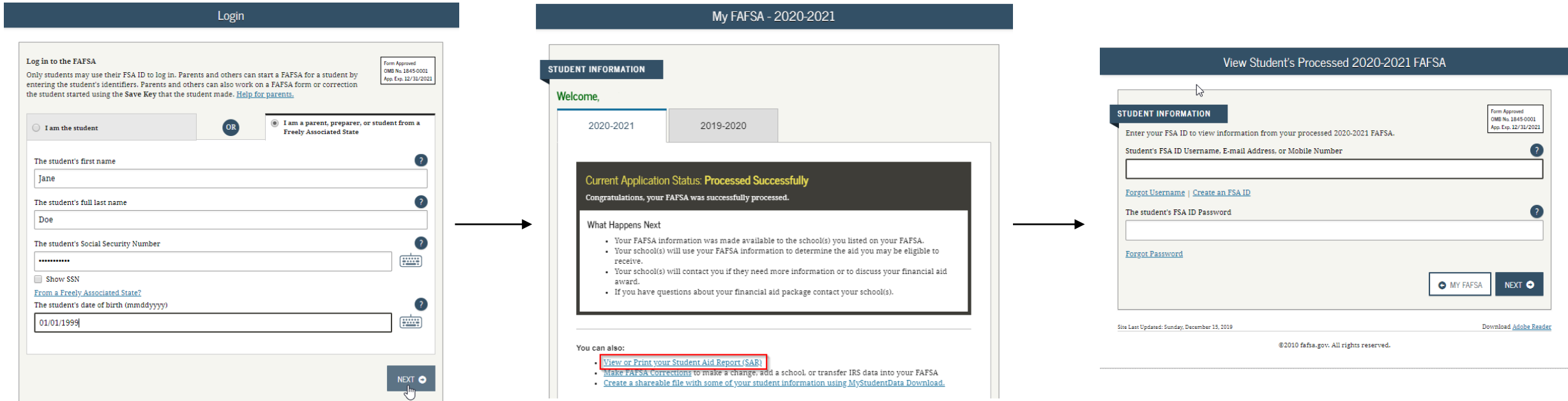
