
How to Accept/ Decline/ Modify Your Aid in Athena

Does a student have to accept gift aid in Athena?

If a student is awarded gift aid (grants, such as the Federal Pell Grant and/or scholarships, such as the HOPE and Zell Miller Scholarships), those funds are automatically accepted for the student in Athena. No action on the student's part is required.

What aid may a student accept/ decline/ modify in Athena?

If a student is awarded self-help aid, a student may accept/ decline/ modify self-help aid in Athena.

Definition of Self-Help Aid

Self-Help Aid:


Financial aid in the form of Federal Direct Student loans and/ or Federal Work Study.

Federal Direct Student Loans are used to help pay the remaining net costs after gift aid is deducted. Federal Direct Student Loans must be repaid.

Federal Work Study is a limited funds, need-based financial aid program in which eligible students work part-time on-campus while enrolled at the University.


Work Study funds <u>must be earned</u> and are not applied toward a student's UGA account balance.

How to Accept/ Decline/ Modify Self-Help Aid in Athena




Login to Athena at athena.uga.edu and click on the Financial Aid tab.

Select Award Year & Then Click on Financial Aid Offer Tab




Scroll Down on the Financial Aid Offer Tab to Reach Accept/ Decline/ Modify Options for Self-Help Aid



If you select "Modify" you may type in a lesser amount that the amount listed.


This amount will be split equally over the semesters listed. Click "Ok" to submit.





What if I am offered Federal Direct Student Loans for two semesters but wish to accept a loan amount for one semester only?

You may submit a **Change-in-Aid Request** via OSFA's Secure Portal to request a Federal Direct Student loan amount for one semester only. The 2023-24 Change-in-Aid Request will become available via OSFA's Secure Portal in early July. Students must accept FWS for both semesters.
